

Designed and created for the Doors Open Toronto, the 50-limited edition self-tie bowties were hand-fabricated and sold for charity. All ties were unisex, ranging in sizes small, medium and large and features various materials from cotton to silk, accommodating differing formalities and occasions. The bowtie, an accessory that blurs the line between casual and formal, is a familiar symbol of architectural figures – from Le Corbusier to Walter Gropius. The minimal and contemporary straight-end design offeres a slim appearnace, suggesting a modern notion to a classic accessory.
